

9.0 INDIRECT EFFECTS

CEQA Guidelines (Section 15358) require a discussion of potential indirect impacts of a proposed project. Indirect impacts are impacts caused by a project that occur later in time or are farther removed in distance, but are still reasonably foreseeable.

There are no substantial impacts that would occur later in time or that are removed in distance in the case of the Proposed Projects to replace the DCP Unit 1 and 2 steam generators. Indirect effects are actually direct effects in that they occur directly as a result of a project, although the relationship between the cause and effect of the impact may be somewhat obscure for indirect effects. The Proposed Projects have the potential for temporary indirect effects and these potential effects have been considered in this document on a resource-by-resource basis. All project impacts that could occur in the future or at distance, are discussed and analyzed in Section 5. No significant indirect effects would result from the Proposed Projects.
