Narrative: SQRU 08 encompasses a narrow portion of Chuckwalla Valley along the south side of I-10 between SQR Units 06 (to the north) and 09 (to the south). Although the Chuckwalla Mountains provide a backdrop of visual interest, Unit 08 is flat and relatively non-descript with low growing grasses and shrubs. Compared to Unit 09 to the immediate south, the Unit 08 landscape is substantially more impacted by built utility infrastructure and less influenced by bordering mountains and ridges.
