I strongly oppose the Sunrise PowerLink! Here's why:

1st - The proposed 18 story structures will **visually blight** 2 of our San Diego backcountry treasures – Anza Borrego Desert State Park & Cleveland National Forest. (where I ran wild as a kid growing up in SD.) & not just visually blight. Building/installing these structures (18 stories!) will negatively impact the ecology of each region that they go through, & ...deposit a permanent increased risk of fires. We have so few fully natural spaces left in our region.
