Dear Ms. Wiggans,

We are in receipt of your request for permission to conduct testing on our property in San Felipe Valley

for an alternative route for the Sunrise Powerlink Project.

We are currently researching our rights in the matter, as well as, consulting with affected neighbors in

the valley. When we have completed this process we will promptly reply to your request.

Please be aware that we are fundamentally against this proposed Alternative Route for a variety of reasons, which include:

1. The Proposed Route is least offensive and sensitive (with the exception of intruding upon the Pacific Crest Trail). There is also precedent with existing power transmission lines in Grapevine Canyon.
 2. The Alternative Route in San Felipe Valley is entirely within protected lands until it reaches our properties. There is, just east of us, the San Felipe Hills Wilderness Study Area which would be effected.
 3. The Alternative Route would essentially render our, and neighboring, properties useless and worthless.
 4. We believe that there are health issues for those people living under or near high voltage power lines.
- and, of course, the pristine beauty of the San Felipe Valley would be ruined forever.
