Question #1

Regarding circuit (C) 1444 crossing Interstate 805 (I-805), according to Caltrans there is a planned circuit crossing I-805 at a center line station approximately 1,100 feet northwest of the Mira Mesa undercrossing. Caltrans has no records for SDG&E rights in this area and believes that this is a new crossing of the freeway. Based on the PEA pages 3-17 and 3-18, it states that C1444 will be routed from the second manhole outside the Substation underground westerly on Vista Sorrento Parkway to existing overhead pole located between Directors Place and Vista Sorrento Parkway. New overhead conductor will be installed on existing poles crossing the I-805 freeway. Please clarify whether the proposed crossing is a new crossing.

SDG&E Response to Question 1:

C1444 will pick up existing Circuit 529 out of the Genesee Substation. C1444 will use an existing freeway crossing with C748 under build with TL665. SDG&E will have double circuit (7-wires construction) on existing transmission and distribution poles. Therefore, SDG&E is not proposing a new crossing. Attached are documents from the City of San Diego establishing rights for the I-805 crossing. Route I-805 was adopted on July 15th, 1960.

Gentlemen:

This Office hereby grants permission to the San Diego Gas & Electric Company to install and maintain an overhead electric power line within an area 12.00 feet in width, being 6.00 feet measured at right angles on each side of the center-line as shown in red on attached San Diego Gas & Electric Company Drawing S-3607 (Revised 4-16-70), subject to the following terms and conditions:

1. HOLD HARMLESS - GENERAL

Company shall at all times indemnify and save harmless City against and pay in full any and all loss, damage or expense that City may sustain, incur or become liable for, resulting in any manner from the construction, maintenance, use, state of repair or presence of Company's facilities installed hereunder and all fixtures and equipment used in connection therewith, including any such loss, damage or expense arising out of (a) loss of or damage to property, and (b) injury to or death of persons, excepting any loss, damage or expense and claims for loss, damage or expense resulting in any manner from the negligent act or acts of the City, its contractors, officers, agents or employees.

2. CITY PERMITTED TO USE SUBSURFACE AND AIRSPACE - RELOCATION AT COMPANY EXPENSE

City reserves the right to use and to grant easements in the subsurface and airspace over, under and about said real property for the installation of such improvements as it shall now or in the future deem necessary which do not interfere with Company's use of said land. City shall notify Company, in writing, at least thirty (30) days prior to the date when said rights are to be exercised, and in the event that Company shall object to City's proposed use of said real property, City and Company shall endeavor, in good faith, to settle, adjust and

compromise such objection. In the event that City and Company are unable to settle, adjust and compromise Company's objection within a reasonable time, Company shall relocate any facilities located within said real property at its own expense.

3. COMPANY PERMITTED TO KEEP PERMIT AREA CLEAR

Company, its successors or assigns, shall have the following rights when necessary for the operation of said permit area: (a) trim or top and keep trimmed or topped, or remove, upon notice to City, any and all trees situated within said germit area, (b) (clear and keep clear all brush and other material situated within said permit area, and (c) cut such roots within said permit area as are necessary for the protection of any improvements located therein by Company. Provided, however, that Company shall not by its activities hereunder cause any damage to adjacent property.

4. TEMPORARY PERMIT

This temporary permit is granted for a limited period and may be terminated by City, its successors and assigns, upon ninety (90) days' notice at any time. Upon receipt by Company, its successors or assigns, of such notice of termination of the permit, said Company, its successors or assigns, agree to vacate the premises and to remove, within a reasonable time thereafter, any and all installations made by it pursuant to this permit, and to restore the premises to the same or as good condition as that which existed prior to granting herein, such removal and restoration to be effected at Company's expense to the satisfaction of City.
