Response to Comment Set D.69: Joan M. Tyler

- D.69-1 We recognize that Alternative 5 would constrain the ability to aggressively fight a wildland fire in the vicinity of the route, and would create additional fire risks to inhabited areas such as Leona Valley and Agua Dulce (see discussion in Section D.5). Your concerns will be shared with the decision-makers who are reviewing the Project and alternatives at the USDA Forest Service and the CPUC.
- D.69-2 These activities are described and were considered in the EIR/EIS in Section C.9, Land Use and Recreation.
