Pursuant to the California Public Utilities Commission's (CPUC) General Order 131-D, Pacific Gas & DEPUTY Electric Company (PG&E) has filed an application with the CPUC for a Permit to Construct the Defta DFA Capacity Increase Substation Project (Application No. A. 05-08-022).

**Project Background:** PG&E proposes to construct a three-bank 230/21 kV distribution substation on a 5.1-acre site in the City of Antioch. In addition, the project would include a new transmission tower in an existing transmission right-of-way and a temporary access road from the existing southern end of Heidom Ranch Road to the proposed substation site. The temporary access road would require a temporary bridge over Sand Creek. PG&E's project objective is to improve reliability and meet projected electrical load requirements in the Delta Distribution Planning Area. Construction would begin as early as Fall 2006 to meet an in-service date of June 1, 2007, depending on CPUC approval. Substation construction would require approximately eight months of activity over a 10- to 12-month period.

Project Description: Construct and operate a three-bank 230/21 kilovolt (kV) distribution substation and related facilities, know as the Delta 21 kV Distribution Planning Area (DPA) Capacity Increase Substation Project. The facility would be constructed in the southern part of the City of Antioch on a 5.1 acre parcel adjacent to an existing 230 kV transmission line. The site is approximately 1 mile south of the intersection of Lone Tree Way and Hillcrest Avenue and approximately 0.4 mile west of the intersection of Heidorn Ranch Road and Sand Creek Road. Property in the immediate vicinity of the site currently is undeveloped. Property in the project vicinity has been designated for residential and other development. The substation would step down the voltage of electric power from the existing transmission line for distribution in the DPA. Construction is planned for 2006-2007, with completion in 2007.
