Clarence Brown of the Viejas Tribe served as the Tribal representative to monitor construction efforts at the Alpine Underground on Link 4 from December 20-24, 2010. Only one day required his monitoring efforts, December 23 for a fraction of the day.

II. CONSTRUCTION ACTIVITIES

Pot-holing on Vault 9 and the track drilling of nine holes approximately 18 feet deep was conducted in fill soils. Subsurface fiber optics were reached.
