INTRODUCTION

During the week of 11/21/2010 through 11/27/2010, construction continued at the Alpine RFO, Alpine Construction Yards, San Luis Rey Substation, Encina Switchyard, the Rough Acres Construction Yard and the Thomas Yard.

Pre-Construction Activity with appropriate monitors:

Link 1: one crew on 11/23/2010, marking 12 kV relocation and staking TSAPs.

Link 4, Field review of alignment with CPUC Lead Monitor and Link Lead, one pot-hole conducted to verify UG utilities, monitors present, 11/24/2010.

Link 5, six crews marked towers, reference points (RPs) and ESAs along with GPS verification, 11/22/2010. Four crews marked towers, RPs and GPS verification, 11/23/2010.

The following is a summary of construction activity where monitors were on site.

Alpine RFO: Minimal contractor activity on site as clean-up was performed and all crews stayed within flagged areas.

Alpine Construction Yard: Equipment and reels delivered on a limited basis.

San Luis Rey Substation: Installation of capacitor banks and other equipment continued. A small area of excavation conducted for a transformer pad and containment.

Rough Acres Construction Yard: Two or three deliveries of reels per day. Storage within air strip.

Encina Switchyard: No ground disturbing work being conducted. Only SDG&E on site until early December.

Thomas Yard: Deliveries of material conducted, including 11/26/2010 and 11/27/2010.

A rain event occurred on 11/23/2010 and 11/24/2010. Precipitation amounts observed: .75 at Encina Switchyard; trace amount at Alpine RFO and Construction Yards. Pre and post rain event inspection of BMPs were made with no deficiencies.
