INTRODUCTION

Construction continued at the Alpine Regional Field Offices (ARFO), the Alpine Construction Yard and the South Bay Substaion Upgrade. On 9/27/2010, construction began at the San Luis Rey Substation although delivery of material had been the only activity from 9/16/2010 through 9/26/2010. No new areas of construction commenced during the time period of 9/26/2010 through 10/2/2010.

Alpine RFO and Construction Yard: Monitors continue to be on site. During a rain event of 9/30/2010, all BMP's were visibly checked and minor adjustments made. A review of air emissions logs was conducted by SDG&E's consultant, Bluescape. Guidance was given to all contractors maintaining the logs and everything was found to be in good order.

South Bay Substation Upgrade: Monitors continue to be on site. Trenching was conducted between the equipment racks and the control house. During a rain event of 9/30/2010, BMP's were visibly checked and found to be in good order.

San Luis Rey Substation Upgrade: Excavation began for pads in two areas. Stockpiles were maintained with BMP's and the driveway cleaned at the end of each day to prevent track-out. During a rain event of 9/30/2010, BMP's were visibly checked and found to be in good order.

Safe Worker and Environmental Awareness (SWEAP) and Wildland Fire Training continue to be conducted twice weekly to assure Project workers are trained.
