#### **Sunrise Powerlink Transmission Project** Weekly Monitoring Report No. 00804

From: 01/30/2011 Through: 02/05/2011

#### INTRODUCTION

During the week of 01/30/2011 through 02/05/2011, construction continued at the Alpine RFO, Alpine Construction Yards, San Luis Rey Substation, Encina Switchyard, the Rough Acres Construction Yard Phase I & II Use, the Thomas Yard, Link 4 Underground, Link 3, Suncrest Substation, and for NTP No. 13 for Links 1, 2 & 5, non-Federal lands only. On 2/3/2011 the Bureau of Land Management, Notice to Proceed (NTP) #1 was received for the Imperial Valley Substation and on 2/4/2011 final approval to start construction was received.

Native American Representatives: The following Representatives monitored during this period at various construction sites on Links 1, 3, 4 and 5: Dan Mason, Carlos Quevedo, Andrea Najera, Bert Quihuis, Brad Comeau, Isabel Cordova, Tom Taylor, Brian Williams.

Wildlife Reporting: The following listed or Species of Special Concern were found dead in Project construction limits during this period:

Seven (7) Silvery legless lizards (Anniella pulchra pulchra); one (1) Coronado Skink (Plestiodon skiltonianus interparietalis); Acorn woodpecker (Melanerpes formicivorus) -- not construction related

Pre-Construction Activity with appropriate monitors:

Monday, 1/31/2011: Five crews conducted tower/access road /TSAP staking and GPS verification surveys; two crews conducting land surveys, two crews conducting biological surveys.

Tuesday, 2/01/2011: Five crews conducted tower/access road /TSAP staking and GPS verification surveys;; Four crews conducted land surveys.

Wednesday, 2/02/2011: Five crews conducted tower/access road /TSAP staking and GPS verification surveys; Two crews conducted tower staking and reference point verification; Two crews conducted land surveys.

Thursday, 2/03/2011: Five crews conducted tower/access road /TSAP staking and GPS verification surveys; Two crews conducted tower staking and reference point verification; Two crews conducted land surveys.

Friday, 2/04/1011: Five crews conducted tower/access road /TSAP staking and GPS verification surveys; Two crews conducted tower staking and reference point verification; Two crews conducted land surveys.

Saturday, 2/05/2011: Three crews conducted staking for EP 73 tower and 12kV relocations; Seven crews conducted tower staking; Two crews conducted land surveys.

During this reporting period, there was a rain event on Sunday, 1/30/2011. Precipitation amounts recorded as follows: Alpine, 0.10 inches; Rough Acres and Jacumba area of Link 1, trace amounts <0.10 inches; Link 3, Suncrest Site, 0.30 inches. Installation of BMPs conducted at all sites given CPUC clearance. Maintenance and repairs were conducted on BMPs as identified in existing areas. Minor leaks and drips from equipment were contained and cleaned. Leaks and drips are also recorded in the SWPPP log along with reporting to appropriate agencies as needed.

Summary of Construction Yard activities where monitors were on site for any set-up and ground disturbing activities:

JVR, Helix, Hartung, Bartlett-Hauser Yards, Kreutzkamp: TTS-I continued installation of BMPs, access grading, vegetation clearing, disking (at some sites) and fence installation. Wash station coordination by providing reference sheets to biological monitors and clarification for implementation of the Weed Control Plan.

#### ALL LINKS

The following is a summary of construction activity where monitors were on site:

Alpine RFO: No ground disturbing work conducted.

Alpine Construction Yard: Equipment, reel and monopole deliveries were made.

San Luis Rey Substation: TBEA contractor on site building transformer. Roel construction is on site and excavation work being conducted. Work conducted Saturday and Sunday (approval from City of Oceanside), 2/5 and 2/6/2011.

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Rough Acres Construction Yard: TTS-I conducting steel delivery and inventory control. Daley Corp. conducted work on the helicopter pad. National Electric Works on site to install security camera and electrical box. PAR continued with steel tower assembly. The Sunbird was mobilized to move tower assembly to tower sites.

Encina Switchyard: Contractor TBEA on site building a transformer. Contractor Roel has mobilized on site. Monitors present for footing and trenching activity. Work conducted on Saturday, 2/5/2011.

Thomas Yard: No ground disturbing work being conducted. The Link Lead monitored a pair of Burrowing Owls observed in the SouthEast corner of the yard, where no Sunrise activity is being conducted.

Link 4 Underground:

Excavations were conducted at vaults (V) 6, 7, 12, and 19. V7 was set on 2/1/2011 and V19 was set on 2/03/2011. Ins/Outs conducted on V14, V15, V 16, V17. Vegetation clearing, tree trimming and BMP installation took place on the Bauer and Loritz properties and Alpine Blvd. Work conducted for the Viejas Bridge Hang.

Work on V9 on Saturday, 2.05.2011 along with vegetation clearing/tree trimming in areas already in progress.

Minor hydraulic fluid leaks were released on 1/31/11, 2/3/2011 and 2/4/2011. All were immediately contained cleaned up and were not in storm water, waterways or ESAs. Reporting was made to the County of San Diego, Storm Water Hotline and to CalTrans.

Link 3 Suncrest Substation and Wilson Yard: Vegetation removal continued on the pad; rough grading along the access road, BMP and fence installation at the Wilson Construction Yard and BMP maintenance in other areas as needed. During this period there were 5 biologists, 3 archaeologists and 3 Native American monitors on site in various locations. One minor leak of diesel from a dump truck was reported on 2/3/2011 and was immediately contained and cleaned up. The leak was not near a wetland or waterway and did not require reporting.

Links 1, 2 & 5, NTP No. 13: Link 1: Grading between EP 210 and EP 211, between EP 215 and EP 219. Rough grading for access road at EP208. Drilling at EP 210, EP 211, EP 215. Clearing at EP217 to EP219. Sunbird mobilized to move structure pieces to tower sites. Survey of tower sites EP 227, EP 228, EP 253, EP 254, EP 236 and EP 237 and the access road for EP 247 and EP 248. 2/5/2011, drilling at EP 213, leg assembly at EP 218, grading at EP 220. 2/5/2011 a minor hydraulic fluid leak was released into soil at EP 244. It was immediately contained and cleaned up. There was no waterway, storm water or ESA affected and did not require reporting.

Link 2: Soil boring at EP89-1, EP90 and EP91. On 2/4/2011, water containing drilling polymer was released onto soil at EP89-1. It was immediately contained and cleaned up. There was no waterway, storm water or ESA affected and did not require reporting.

Link 5: Soil boring at CP31. Geological investigation at CP20. CP29-1 rough grading for access road. Access road improvements to Helix Construction Yard

Imperial Valley Substation Upgrade: Mobilization and ground disturbing (trenching) activity is scheduled to begin on Monday, 2/7/2011.
