This letter is in response to the proposed Modified Route D Alternative for the SDG&E Sunrise Powerlink Project. We are opposed to the modified Route D Alternative and find it to be in direct violation of all that we stand for and oppose it in its entirety.

The area is a rural setting with mountains, meadows, oak trees, much wildlife and geological interests. We have so enjoyed the peace, quiet and beautiful view in the home that we built twenty three years ago. The Sunrise Powerlink Project would destroy all this for us.

There would be a need for a road to install this project and maintain it. Noise would be a great factor both from the lines and from travel. The other residences nearby would also be affected and in danger as the Primitive Area of Hauser Canyon, a dangerous fire area, all ready claimed the lives of eleven people in the past.

The modified Route D Alternative is a bad idea on many levels and should be eliminated quickly in order to focus time and resources on more viable alternatives.
