**1. Discussion: Progress of CBMWD to provide recycled water to the city of Monterey Park.**

- **Permanent Recycled Water pipeline** - Lonnie stated CBMWD is adding to the scope of work on the additional infrastructure to accommodate Cal Trans. Frank Heldman mentioned Pine Tree park area may be a possible solution for Reclaimed Storage and Booster pumps.
- **LA County Health Department** - a preliminary plan and/or feasible concept plan needs to be submitted to the Health Department to see if they agree with the approach of providing the "temporary solution" to Edison and MPK's Market Place Project.
  - Roman mentioned that Health Department stated there are Restrictions on serving more than one parcel with one connection. Therefore, a preliminary plan to the Health Department for review and comment before dedicating any additional time and effort on the temporary connection needs to be submitted.
- **Monterey Park (MPK)** - will continue to seek out pipeline inspection contractors to video, jet, and survey the culvert as a temporary connection with the anticipation Health Department will approve the temporary connection solution.
- **Summary** - Lonnie mentioned he will increase efforts to get something in place in terms of design. In order to allow reclaimed water to cross the 60 freeway.
- **CBMWD** - will provide MPK with executed agreements with other agencies showing the various arrangements for delivering the reclaimed water. This will provide insight and understanding to the options available to MPK in entering an agreement to accept and deliver reclaimed water.
