Dear Ms. De Llanos:

This letter is to inform you that your Tier I Application was received on April 30, 2015, for a proposed easement in support of Line 3602, a Natural Gas Transmission Project onboard Marine Corps Air Station (MCAS) Miramar. I understand that SDG&E and SoCalGas plan to request approval from the California Public Utilities Commission (CPUC) to construct, operate, and maintain an approximately 50-mile-long, 36-inch-diameter natural gas transmission pipeline that will carry natural gas from SDG&E's existing Rainbow Metering Station to the pipeline's terminus an existing SDG&E (Line 2010) on MCAS Miramar.

Your request was forwarded to the CLAMP for their review, and a few initial comments have been received. SDG&E will be sent a final response at the end of the review period, however in order to assist in expediting your request, please be advised that MCAS Miramar will expect a detailed Health and Safety Plan as part of this project. Additionally, your request for a "permanent/perpetual" easement is under review. A recommendation on your request will be provided to our Commanding Officer for a final decision. Keep in mind that the CLAMP's review process can be lengthy and you may be contacted for additional information. Due to the nature and complexity of this project it will require further review at our higher headquarters.
