The City of San Diego Public Utilities Department (PUD) has been contacted by San Diego Gas & Electric (SDG&E) regarding construction of SDG&E's proposed Sycamore to Penasquitos 230 kilovolt Transmission Line (Project), located primarily within existing SDG&E right-of-way or franchise position within the City of San Diego. The Project will require construction water for grading, fire suppression, dust control, soil compaction and potentially other construction related activities.

The permitting authority for the Project, the California Public Utilities Commission (CPUC), requested that SDG&E and/or its contractors obtain written documentation from all potential sources of construction water confirming that an increased quantity of water will be available for use on the Project during a specified period of time.

At the request of SDG&E, PUD hereby confirms that approximately 25 million gallons of potable and recycled water shall be available for Project use during construction which is currently scheduled to begin in June, 2016.
