## NOTICE OF INTENT TO ADOPT A MITIGATED NEGATIVE DECLARATION

## **To All Interested Parties:**

Pursuant to California Public Utilities Code Section 1001 and the California Public Utilities Commission (CPUC) General Order 131-D, Looking Glass Networks, Inc. (LGN) submitted an application for a Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity (CPCN) for the proposed project to install fiber optic conduits and related facilities to urban areas of the San Francisco Bay Area and Los Angeles Basin known as the Looking Glass Networks Fiber Optics Project (A.02-05-029). LGN proposes to install conduit and related facilities as a means of creating metropolitan area networks (MANs) to serve aggregation points in the San Francisco Bay Area and the Los Angeles Basin within California. Fiber optic equipment would be installed to provide Ethernet and optical networking access, switching, and multiplexing equipment. The proposed project would utilize existing conduit networks, limit new conduit construction (primarily only to interconnect existing systems), and/or use backbones of existing (or future) fiber optic networks. Where existing facilities may not be in place, the Applicant may be required to build laterals from these backbones to connect to the targeted buildings. Construction is expected to utilize State and local Right of Ways (ROWs) and other designated utility corridors.

Based on the information provided in the IS/MND, it has been determined that the proposed project would not have any significant effects on the environment.
