Dear Billie Blanchard,

Feb. 5, 2007

Since I now live in Indiana, I learned of the renewed attempt to build high transmission powers lines across the Anza Boreggo Desert State Park only recently. My husband and I are still opposed to such construction.

I have had a long love of the Anza-Borrego. It began when I was a child in San Diego and my parents, sister and I would go out to the desert at every opportunity in the late 1930's. When we returned home to San Diego after the WWII, my mother, sister and I renewed our visits. My father did not survive the war.

After I was married, the State Park became the favorite winter camping destination for my husband, two children and me in the 60's. During that time, we joined the Sierra Club

and I became active with the conservation committee of the San Diego Chapter. Also during that time, Harriet Allen, Joe Read, Doc Parker, Jim Whitehead, myself and others formed the Anza-Borrego Committee. I was, also, for many years Membership secretary for the Desert Protective Council.

During the late 60's, San Diego Gas &Electric contacted the SD Chapter conservation committee regarding the building of high power transmission lines across the Anza – Borrego State Park. I think they hoped to get our support of the endeavor. Mr. Sinnott, then president of SDG&E, sent Frank Devore to meet with us. He tried everything, including a lunch with Mr. Sinnott in the SDG&E executive dining room. Frank Devore, also, told me that SDG&E would paint the towers any color we wanted. I guess he thought that since there were many women in the Conservation Committee, that designer colors would sway us. However, they did not and the San Diego Chapter remained opposed. We did not oppose building the lines around the bottom of the Park out side the boundary line at the time. The matter seemed to go away.

Now the specter of high power transmission line across the State Park has again risen its ugly head. My husband and I are completely opposed to the Sunrise Powerlink plans, as we were to SDG&E plans in the past. De-designation of wilderness in a State Park should never be allowed for development of any kind, private or otherwise.

This is a long e-mail, but I wanted you to know that I'm not just a Hoosier butt-in-sky. I may not be in California any longer but my love of the Anza-Borrego remains.


