Dear Mr. Johnson,

On January 29, 2009, Southern Californian Edison (SCE) submitted a variance request for the extension of approved construction work hours at Structures 22 and 23 (referred to as the Haskell Canyon Crossing) in Segment 1, Section 1. This Variance Request is approved by CPUC for the proposed activities based on the following factors:

- As specified in the variance request, in order to take full advantage of the scheduled outage to the existing high-voltage transmission lines between Structures 22 and 23 (referred to as the Haskell Canyon Crossing), SCE is requesting permission to have their crews work on Sunday, February 1st, from 6:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m. The work to be performed is located parallel to City Highline Road just north of Copper Hill Drive outside the city limits of Santa Clarita, within Los Angeles County.
- Construction activities will include the stringing of new conductor (wire) across the existing high-voltage lines.
- On January 29, 2009, Los Angeles County issued an exemption to their noise ordinance allowing work on Sunday, February 1st.

The conditions noted below shall be met by SCE and its contractors:

- All project mitigation measures, compliance plans, and permit conditions shall be implemented during construction activities. Some measures are on-going/time-sensitive requirements and shall be implemented prior to and during construction where applicable.
- Copies of all relevant permits, compliance plans, and this Variance shall be available on site for the duration of construction activities.
