Meeting Purpose: Section 15083 of the Guidelines for Implementation of the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) indicates that a Lead Agency preparing an EIR may consult directly with any person or organization it believes will be concerned with the environmental effects of a proposed project. Lead agencies have often found that early consultation with the public can identify environmental concerns that should be addressed in an EIR and may arise as issues later in the project review process. This early consultation with the public is called *scoping*. Scoping helps agencies to identify the range of actions, alternatives, mitigation measures and significant effects to be analyzed in depth in an EIR and eliminate from detailed study issues found not to be important.
