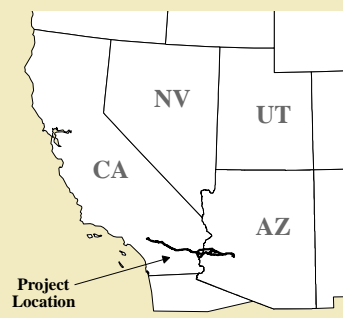
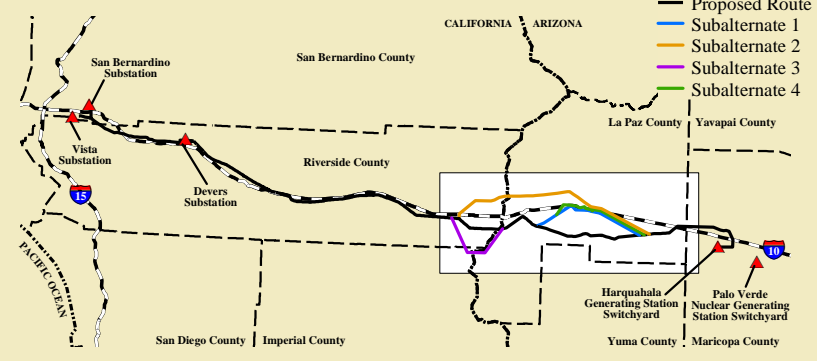


Map 3-1 SUBALTERNATE ROUTES CONSIDERED IN THE 1988 PEA
