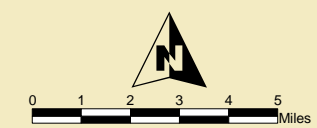
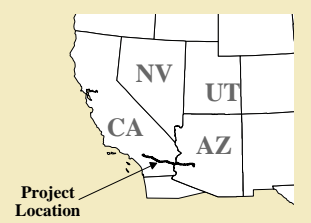


Panel Index Map
