#### INTRODUCTION

This report provides a summary of the construction and compliance activities associated with the SCE DPV2 Transmission and Red Bluff Substation Projects:

A summary of the Notices to Proceed (NTPs) with construction and Variance Request activity are also provided (see Tables 1 and 2, respectively, near the end of this report). Additionally, a summary of Temporary Extra Workspace Requests (TEWS) is provided in Table 3.

**CPUC/Aspen Environmental Monitors (EM)**: Jamie Miner was on site September 15 and 16.

#### **DPV2 CONSTRUCTION AND MATERIAL YARDS**

NTP #1 was issued for construction and set-up of construction yards, including Devers, Desert Center 1 (DC1), Desert Center 2 (DC2), Blythe, Beaumont, and Menifee Construction Yards.

#### **Summary of Activity:**

- 1. All major construction activities have been completed at the Blythe, DC1, DC2, Devers, Beaumont, and Menifee Construction Yard. Current activities at these yards are those associated with layout by Kenny Construction.
- 2. Construction activities conducted at the Devers Construction Yard included continued grading of site, installation of gravel, and installation of desert tortoise and site boundary fencing (see Figures 1 and 2).
- 3. Activities associated with the installation of temporary power poles were conducted at DC1 and DC2. Activities were completed at DC2 to repair fencing along eastern boundary that had been damaged due to high winds several weeks ago. The amount of fence posts along the eastern and western boundaries were doubled to reinforce fencing in these areas.

#### **Environmental Compliance:**

- 1. In compliance with Mitigation Measure T-7a, road improvements, which would be limited to installation of a gravel base and grading, were approved by the CPUC EM at the offsite water location for the Devers Construction Yard on September 15 (see Figure 3).
- 2. The contractor questioned whether or not trenches for desert tortoise fencing could be left open over the weekend if suitable escape ramps were constructed (see Figure 4). The CPUC EM consulted with the project desert tortoise biologists and determined that this would not be in compliance with Mitigation Measures and conditions of the BO. Therefore, the contractor committed to completing all desert tortoise fencing prior to the end of the work week.
- 3. BMPs were observed to be in sufficient condition at the Devers Construction Yard during the subject period. All BMPs associated with major construction of the remaining yards have been removed.
- 4. Compliance measures, including dust suppression, secondary containment, tracker plates, and protective netting to cover heavy equipment and materials was observed throughout the subject period (see Figure 5).

#### DPV2 EXCLUSIONARY FENCING AT 41 TOWER LOCATIONS

NTP #2 was issued by CPUC for the installation of Coachella Valley fringe-toed lizard (*Uma inornata*) and flat-tailed horned lizard (*Phrynosoma mcallii*) exclusionary fencing at 41 tower locations between the Devers Substation and Indio.

#### **Summary of Activity:**

- 1. No activities associated with NTP #2 were conducted during the subject period. However, a field study was conducted to verify information provided in the pre-construction survey report for biological resources, dated August 30, 2011. Based on a review of that report and the subsequent field study, NTP #2 was approved with the following issues requiring resolution prior to any ground-disturbing activities at the applicable tower locations:
  - a. Desert tortoise burrows that have been identified during recent surveys at tower location #2013 are not flagged for avoidance. SCE shall implement the appropriate Mitigation Measures and BO conditions, including avoidance or relocation, if required.
  - b. SCE must provide concurrence from CDFG or a sufficient justification for non-jurisdiction related to a potentially jurisdictional drainage that occurs between the spur road and the fence boundary at tower location #2102.
  - c. SCE must resolve debris removal issues at tower locations where removal activities will be required to install fencing.
  - d. If SCE wants to use access (main access road only) road for parking. The desired areas need to be identified and would be subject to a TEWS or variance request.
  - e. A pair of juvenile birds (unidentified species) was observed in an existing tower immediately adjacent to location #2200. It could not be determined if a nest was present or not. SCE's biologist should be prepared to initiate appropriate buffers, if required.

## **BEAUMONT #2 CONSTRUCTION YARD**

NTP #3 was issued for construction activities associated with the development of the Beaumont #2 Construction Yard.

#### **Summary of Activity:**

1. No activities associated with NTP #3 were conducted during the subject period.

#### INDIO CONSTRUCTION YARD

NTP #4 was issued for construction activities associated with the development of the Indio Construction Yard.

#### **Summary of Activity:**

1. No activities associated with NTP #4 were conducted during the subject period.

No NCRs or PM were issued for construction activities during the subject period.
