Responses to Comment Set C20 – Edward H. Leonhardt

- C20-1** Your support for the Partial Underground Alternative has been noted. The Environmentally Superior Alternative has been re-evaluated and is identified in the Recirculated Draft EIR, Section E (July 2008) as the Proposed Project. Please see General Response GR-1 for a discussion regarding the change in determination of the Environmentally Superior Alternative.
- C20-2** Please see response to Comment Set C3.
- C20-3** Original Draft EIR (December 2007) Figure C-6, located on page C-23 of Section C (Alternatives) is meant to illustrate how the duct bank installation would restore the existing topography to the extent feasible. The figure illustrates installation of the duct bank in a hill, which has been restored by the addition of four feet of backfill. The amount of backfill used would vary depending on topography at a given location, but the duct banks and associated vaults would be installed below the existing grade, and thus would not result in a raised mound.
- C20-4** The location of the riser poles associated with the Partial Underground Alternative was provided by SCE during the alternatives development process. All project engineering and design for the Proposed Project (whether it be the project proposed by SCE or one of the alternatives analyzed in the EIR) are finalized after the completion of the CEQA process and CPUC's decision on the project.
- C20-5** The 845 signatures in support of the petition for preparation of an EIR and for the placement of the subtransmission line underground through the community of Sun Lakes are acknowledged. The Environmentally Superior Alternative has been re-evaluated and is identified in the Recirculated Draft EIR, Section E (July 2008) as the Proposed Project. Please see General Response GR-1 for a discussion regarding the change in determination of the Environmentally Superior Alternative.
