I am a member of SLCC citizens who are concerned about the proposal to erect above-ground power lines. The majority of the residents living here are opposed to the metal towers for many varied reasons.

Three of us got cancer and I also was diagnosed with a benign brain tumor (1998) which was removed at Barrows Neurological Hospital.
