Re: Data Request #2 for the SCE Ivanpah-Control Project (A.19-07-015)

Dear Ms. Charpentier:

Southern California Edison Company (SCE) submitted its Permit to Construct (PTC) application and Proponent's Environmental Assessment (PEA) on July 17, 2019. The California Public Utilities Commission's (CPUC) Energy Division provided a PEA deficiency letter to SCE on August 15, 2019 and SCE is currently preparing responses.

The CPUC is planning to meet with the Bureau of Land Management (BLM) to discuss the CPUC's requirements for consultation with Native American Tribes under AB 52 and approaches to data sharing with Tribes. In preparation for our meeting with BLM, please provide a copy of all the following that apply to the Ivanpah-Control Project:

- Fieldwork Authorization Request (Form 8151-3))
- Application for Permit for Archaeological Investigations (DI Form 1926)
- BLM State Archaeological Permit held by SCE or its contractor

The CPUC is also requesting a copy of any other BLM authorization to SCE or its contractors for the Ivanpah-Control Project that defines procedures or restrictions for sharing of cultural resource data with Tribes.

Additional data requests may be necessary to address other issues as we move forward with scoping and EIR preparation.
