Dear Ms. Charpentier:

Southern California Edison Company (SCE) submitted its Amended Permit to Construct (PTC) application and Proponent's Environmental Assessment (PEA) on April 13, 2020. The PTC application was deemed complete on May 31, 2023. This data request defines additional information required for the notification of publication of the Draft EIR.

Updated Mailing List

SCE's PEA and PTC application was submitted with a mailing list for properties within 300 feet of I-C Project facilities or work areas. A corrected list was submitted in April of 2020. In October of 2024, Segment 4 was eliminated from the project. In addition, the CPUC will also mail notices of the release of the Draft EIR to property owners along the 3 alternative routes in Inyo County.

Since the 2020 mailing list is now over 5 years old and we have added nearly 60 miles of alternative routes to the EIR's study area and removed all of Segment 4, we make the following request:

- Please provide a new, current mailing list for properties within 300 feet of the I-C Project facilities, including all staging areas. The list should be provided in **MS Excel** and should present data in each of the following columns:
 - First name, Last Name, Agency, Street Address, City, State, Zip, Assessor's Parcel Number, and an indication as to whether the owner is near the Proposed Project or one of the 3 alternatives (or both).

Response. Please respond to this request within 4 weeks and provide a copy to our CEQA consultant (Susan Lee at Slee@aspenerg.com). Additional data requests may be necessary to address other issues as we move forward with EIR preparation.
