To Whom It May Concern:

The National Parks Conservation Association (NPCA) expresses its concerns regarding Southern California Edison's Ivanpah and Control Project, particularly as it relates to the Manzanar Realignment Alternative and its potential impact on the Manzanar National Historic Site's viewshed.

Founded in 1919 and with more than 1.9 million members and supporters beside us, NPCA is the voice of America's national parks, working to protect and preserve our nation's most iconic and inspirational places for present and future generations.

The site's remoteness is essential to understanding the hardship and despair faced by the over 11,000 Japanese Americans incarcerated there during World War II as a result of what the Federal Government later admitted was racial prejudice, wartime hysteria and a failure of political leadership.

We urge Southern California Edison to limit any disruption to the Site's viewshed by replacement transmission infrastructure, particularly from such critical locations as the Site's Visitors Center and the Cemetery.
