I have received the Notice of Preparation for the Jefferson-Martin Project in the mail. As I will be unable to attend any of the scoping meetings, I wish to offer my comments in this email.

I would like to voice a strong preference for Alternative 1B, the underground alternative for Conana Road and Skyline. I would like to see the existing line, as well as the new one, placed underground and the towers removed entirely. This will have the following benefits:

* Restore the senic higway to a more original state

* reduce the possibility of impacts on birds

* reduce the possible impacts of an earthquake on motor vehicle traffic

* remove construction from the fragile habitats of Edgewood Park

* reduce the negative impacts on recreational use of nearby trails

In addition, I think the alternative for a generation facility nearer to the points of use should be considered very carefully for its possible impacts and/or relative benefits to the project.

I also feel that reduction of demand should be considered, especially of the concept of highly increased fees for usages significantly above the true needs of entities being supplied with electricity. The last year has shown that there is a demand far in excess of the real needs of those being served.
