We residents of The Highlands have had to endure that eyesore (and hazard) for as many years as I can remember, and there are alternatives. Since there is a plan in the works to upgrade this facility, I would ask that the Utility to be forced to consider **OUR** needs for a change. The lines could be moved west of Hwy. 280 along the watershed property. Or, the lines could be buried underground. To the California Public Utilities Commission,

I am deeply concerned about the proposed Jefferson Martin 230kV Transmission Line Project. I am particularly concerned about the health issues arising from the increased electro magnetic field ("EMF") emissions from the proposed five fold increase in electric transmission so close to our families' homes.

While I am not objecting to having the higher voltage transmission lines, as long as a justifiable needs exists, I am requesting that all possible measures be taken in order to reduce EMF emissions to mitigate the impact on health and well being of our residents.
