We wish the following project issues be addressed:

- PG&E has not demonstrated a clear need for the project in light of recent approvals of energy generation facilities in San Francisco, and energy conservation trends. Four new turbine generators are scheduled for construction in San Francisco and the Potrero Hill generation plant is to be expanded.
- 2) PG&E has failed to explain the urgency of the project.
- PG&E has not considered adequate alternatives to the proposed transmission line routes - underground or overhead west of Highway 280.
