**Potential for Habitat at the Palo Cedro ILA Site to Support Sensitive Species Occurring in the Vicinity**

Ahart's paronychia (*Paronychia ahartii*) is a federal species of concern associated with valley and foothill grassland, vernal pools, and cismontane woodland.

*The Palo Cedro ILA site does not contain appropriate habitat for Ahart's paronychia.*

Slender Orcutt grass (*Orcuttia tenuis*) is a federal threatened and state endangered vernal pool endemic plant.

*The Palo Cedro ILA site does not contain appropriate habitat for slender Orcutt grass.*

Woolly meadowfoam (*Limnanthes floccosa* ssp. *floccosa*) is a CNPS list 2 plant. It occurs in vernal wet areas, ditches, and ponds.

*The Palo Cedro ILA site does not contain appropriate habitat for woolly meadowfoam.*
