I have worked at Fox OUTDOOR school in Santa Ysabel CA, for 20 years. Each week our school educates up to 180 students who live on sight from Monday to Friday. The hikes we lead bring the California Science framework alive! This is their favorite week of the whole school year!

Unfortunately, there is a worrisome problem we face that goes beyond budget cuts. If the Sunrise Powerlink Project goes through, it's very likely that a 500 kV power line will replace the existing line and cut right through Fox outdoor school. One of the existing poles is 20 feet from one of the girls cabins!

I have enclosed 17 student letters (+ 3 teachers) that reflect our response to this information. Also, I've included a route map and some photos of Camp Fox. One of the photos show what may happen (heaven forbid!) to our Pond.

Please do ALL you can do to prevent The Sunrise Powerlink from becoming a reality! Preserving Fox outdoor school is just one more among many for choosing the well documented alternatives for future.

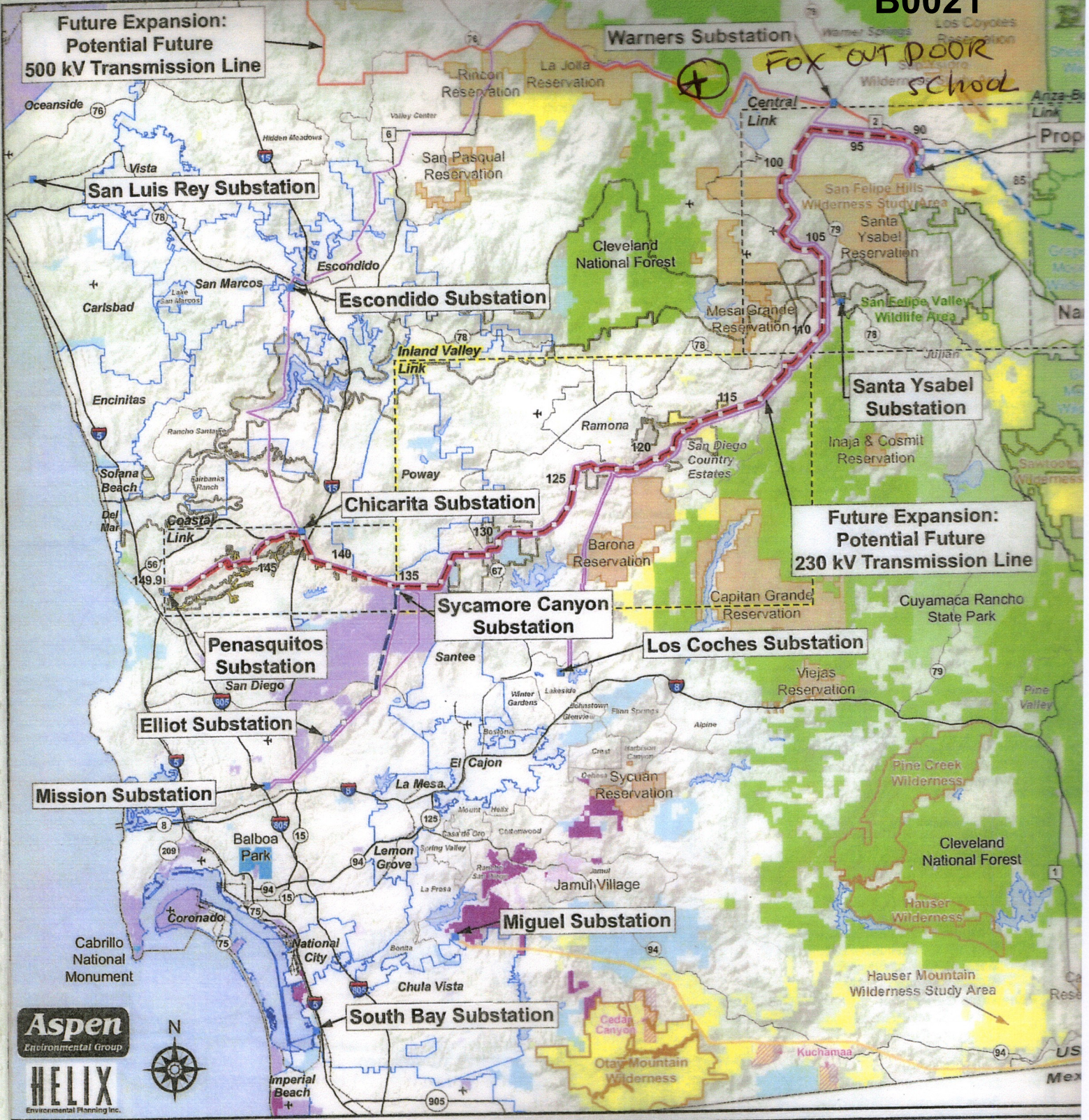



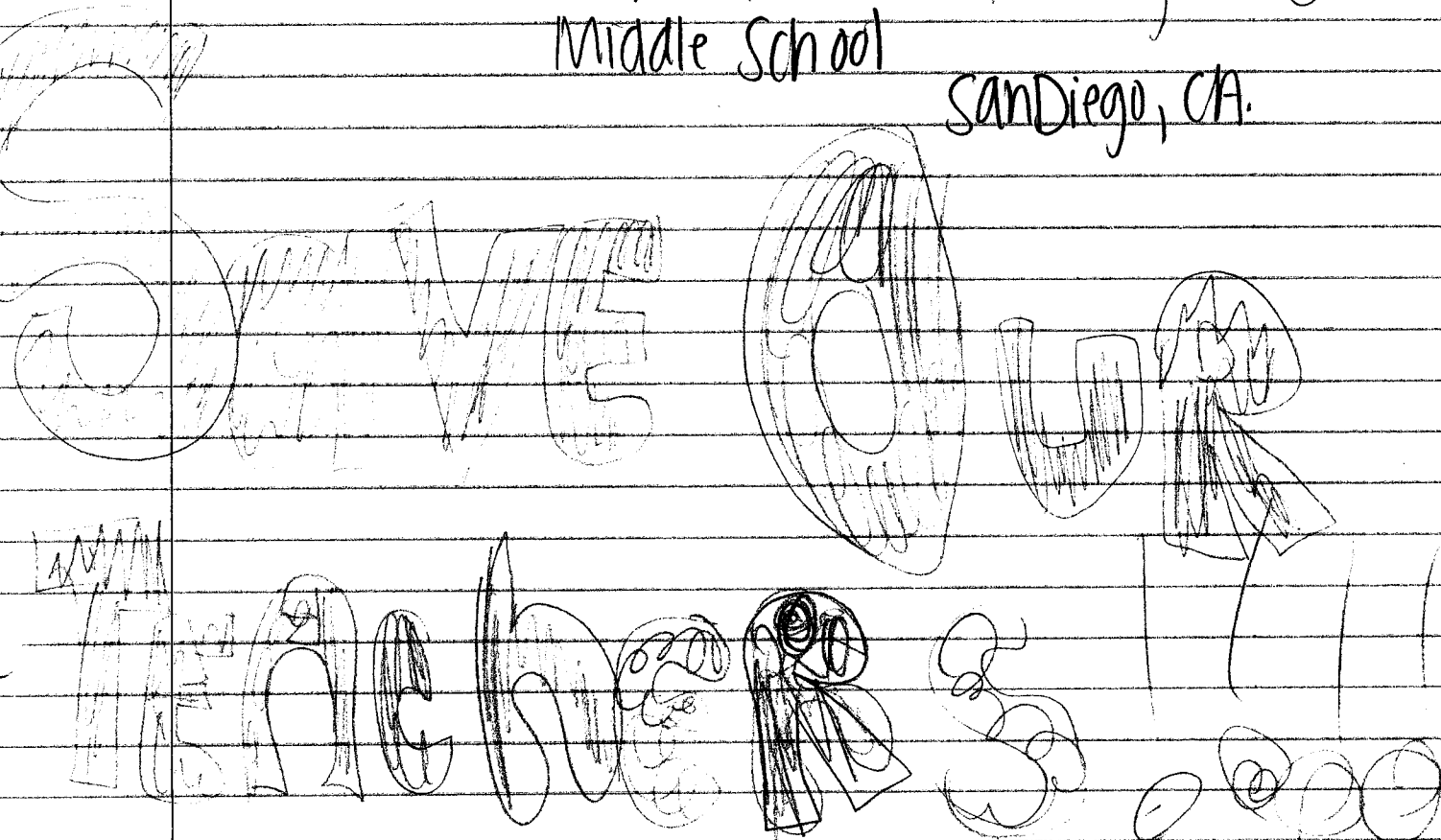
