She confirmed that one of the alternative routes does go very close to your house. Please keep in mind that the CPUC has not made a routing decision yet and you can still submit comments to them. The CPUC contact information is below. The deadline for comments to the draft environmental document is April 11th. Please be sure to submit your comments about the proposal before that date to be sure they get recorded.

I know this is a very difficult situation and I really appreciate your understanding and patience. I will let the consultants know that you want to be notified before anyone goes out to do studies. They will call you directly to let you know when they will be on your property.
