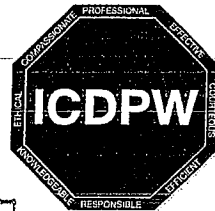

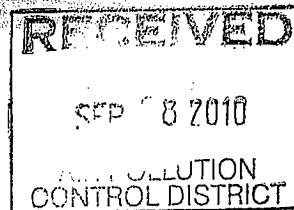

As you are aware the Imperial County Air Pollution Control District (Air District) granted the Imperial County Department of Public Works available SDG&E funds totaling \$365,000 for the above mentioned PM10 Dust Mitigation Project as per your letter dated December 15, 2009. This letter is provided to inform you that the paving work at Sidewinder road was completed, that on September 7, 2010 the Board accepted the work and authorized the final notice of completion.

Attached therefore please find a Final Invoice which outlines includes all Preliminary Engineering, Construction Engineering and Construction costs for the project.

You will also note that the work included provision of class 2 aggregate base material which was purchased by private contract (Masters Construction), DPW force account work for the placement of the base material and the asphalt paving work done by private contract (Granite Construction). Landmark Consultants provided the necessary material testing to ensure all materials met specification and our Resident Engineer responsible for inspection of the asphalt concrete work was Mendoza & Associates. The bottom line is that the project cost far exceeded the available SDG & E funds.

We appreciate the Air District's support and ask that should any future mitigation funding become available to address unpaved roads, please consider DPW again.

SUBJECT: Approval of Release of SDG&E Mitigation Funds to the Imperial County Public Works Department to be used for the paving of 1.5 miles of Sidewinder Road.

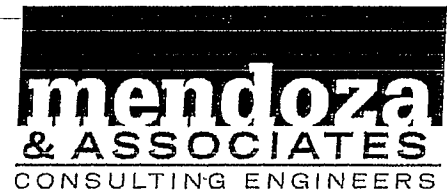
The Imperial County Air Pollution Control District (Air District) has reviewed your request for SDG&E mitigation funds, letter submitted on December 15, 2009. The Imperial County Public Works Department (ICPWD) has proposed to utilize the \$365,000.00 that is currently available to pave 1.5 miles of Sidewinder Road with asphalt concrete (AC). Sidewinder Road is an unpaved road which receives on an average 120 vehicles per day. However this figure tends to fluctuate with the winter season showing an increase due to the usage of off-road enthusiasts and snowbird traffic. Due to the high volume of vehicular traffic, Sidewinder Road is considered to be a large generator of PM10 dust.

Upon review of the available road information, the Air District calculated the emission reductions that could be achieved by paving the above mentioned road segment. The Air District has concluded that the proposed paving project has the potential to mitigate 31.64 tons/year of PM10 dust (see attached memo).

After careful review of the project, the Air District considers the proposed project to be beneficial to the community as it will reduce PM10 dust emissions thus improving traveling conditions and protecting the general public health. Therefore the Air District grants the available SDG&E funding to the ICPWD to carry out the proposed project. Please be advised that ICPWD will be subject to the schedule and terms found in your letter dated December 14, 2009.







**Background:**

On January 28, 2010, the Department released a Request for Proposals for Resident Engineer and Construction Inspection Services for Sidewinder Road Improvements From Interstate 8 to Barney Old Field Road; County Project Number 5099M with a deadline for submittal of proposals were due on February 26, 2010. The RFP was advertised on the Public Works website at [www.co.imperial.ca.us/publicworks](http://www.co.imperial.ca.us/publicworks) under 'projects out to bid.'

On February 26, 2010, the Department received seven (7) which are outlined in the attached proposal score sheet. Proposals were reviewed, scored, and ranked by Department staff based on the selection criteria within the RFP. The scoring documentation reveals that Mendoza and Associates of San Diego was the top ranked consultant. The Department therefore recommends Mendoza and Associates to manage the construction with their resident engineer and inspection services for a not to exceed fee of \$35,716.88.

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
