- 5. A permit has been filed for the wind farm at La Rumorosa but not a single windmill has been built Mexican projects have a history of not being completed so it is premature to require the construction of the Sunrise Powerlink to carry non-existent energy, and
- 6. A much better solution to our energy needs would be in-basin natural gas generation and requiring roof top solar on all new construction.
