The California Public Utilities Commission, as Lead Agency under the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA), and the U.S. Department of the Interior, Bureau of Land Management (BLM) as Lead Agency under the National Environmental Policy Act (NEPA) have prepared a Scoping Report to document the process and comments received regarding the San Diego Gas & Electric (SDG&E) proposed Sunrise Powerlink Transmission Project.

SDG&E proposes transmission line and facility upgrades in San Diego and Imperial Counties. The entire Project would span a total of 150 miles (676 new towers), including a 91-mile 500-kilovolt (kV) transmission line (in Imperial County and eastern San Diego County) and a new 59-mile 230 kV line (in central and western San Diego County) that includes both overhead and underground segments. It would also include a new substation in central San Diego County and upgrades at four existing substations.

In order to hear public and agency concerns on the proposed transmission line project and in compliance with CEQA and NEPA requirements, public scoping was held during September and October of 2006. Seven public meetings were held between October 2 and October 5, 2006 (transcripts are included in the Scoping Report). Over one hundred (100) individuals presented oral comments during the scoping meetings, and over 200 comment letters were submitted during the scoping process.

This Scoping Report is identified as "Part 1" because a second round of scoping will be held in early 2007 to hear the public's input on alternatives. The CPUC and the BLM will hold additional meetings in early February regarding the alternatives to the project that are proposed to be fully analyzed in the EIR/EIS and those determined to be eliminated from detailed analysis. These meetings will be noticed separately and a second scoping report (Part 2) will be prepared and made available for review. The purpose of these additional meetings is to provide the public and government agencies an opportunity to comment on the alternatives identified for consideration in the EIR/EIS.
