
Dear Ms. Blanchard and Kastoll:

I am writing to let you know that there is a strong voice of objection to the proposed Sunrise Powerlink Modified Route D Alternative in our community. My fellow residents and I are angered by the proposal to site 150-foot high power poles and noisy transmission lines across the scenic backdrop of the Cleveland National Forest.

We are proud to live in the quiet rural Mountain Empire because we value it as a unique place of environmental preserve. This scenic quality is so valuable to us that we sacrifice amenities such as higher pay and opportunities for employment that are available to those who live in more urban areas.
