Dear Ms. Blanchard & Ms. Kastoll,

In response to your notice regarding an additional EIR/EIS Alternative to the Proposed Sunrise Powerlink Project, we have the following comments.

Firstly we are property owners in the San Felipe Valley which is currently under consideration as an alternate route for the Powerlink. We have previously objected to this alternate route for a variety of reasons, among them disturbing the pristine nature of the valley, intruding on and degrading environmentally protected lands held by the Dept. of Fish & Game and the BLM, and traveling directly through our property which would render it worthless, not to mention a potential health hazard.

With that in mind, and after study of the proposed alternative of this notice, we whole heartily support a route south of the I-8 Freeway. This makes a lot of sense for a lot of reasons, among them:

- 1. It would have the least impact on existing private lands and homes
- 2. Meet State and Federal agencies needs for protection of forest, wilderness and environmentally sensitive areas.
- 3. Utilize existing easements and structures for powerline construction.
- 4. Reduce engineering and construction costs, which ultimately get passed on to the SDG&E customer.

We hope you will seriously consider the benefits of using this alternate route.
