
Comment Set 15 Letter from Don Seitz dated April 1, 2004



Over the last couple of months, there has been a growing concern from the community regarding Southern California Edison's proposal to install towers and transmission wires along the 3.1 miles of its corridor running from a new substation in Lake Forest to an existing substation in Mission Viejo.

Right now the California Public Utilities Commission (CPUC) is conducting an environmental review of Edison's proposal. The CPUC expects the review to be completed March 9th. Once the report is made public, there are 30 days for the public to comment on the report. If you are interested in receiving a copy, there are several ways to obtain the report. You can visit the CPUC's web site at: <u>www.cpuc.ca.gov</u>. From there, click on "Regulated Areas", then select "Environmental". Choose "Current Projects" and the report will be listed as "SCE Proposed Viejo System Project". You can also obtain the report by going to your local library or planning commission for a copy.

During the comment period, the CPUC will hold a conference for the public to voice its views and concerns. The conference is scheduled for **5:30p.m. on March 25th at City Hall, 200 Civic Center**. All comments will be included in the final CPUC report. An Administrative Judge will attend the conference and from there make a recommendation. The proposal then goes to the CPUC where five Commissioners review documents and vote regarding the final disposition. This last step is not expected to take place until June 2004.
