Subject: Egbert Switching Station Project- Notice to Proceed Request No. 1 (NTP #1)

Dear Mr. Chiang,

The California Public Utilities Commission (CPUC) issued a decision granting Pacific Gas and Electric Company (PG&E) a Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity to authorize construction of the Egbert Switching Station Project (project) (Application A.17-12-021) pursuant to General Order 131-D. The CPUC Decision adopted the Final Environmental Impact Report (EIR), released in December 2019, in its entirety. The Final EIR includes a Mitigation Monitoring, Compliance and Reporting Plan (MMCRP), and the CPUC adopted the MMCRP as part of its approval of the project. In order for PG&E to commence construction, PG&E needs to provide the CPUC with several preconstruction requirements per the MMCRP.

The three previous packages that have been submitted satisfy all the necessary pre-construction requirements for the entire project. The submittal dates are outlined below. This NTP request is the final step in order to satisfy the MMCRP pre-construction requirements for both the transmission line and the switching station portions of the project. All necessary preconstruction cultural and biological surveys will be done prior to the start of construction in accordance with the MMCRP. PG&E would like to start construction of the project as soon as November 1st, 2021.
