LASSEN SUBSTATION PROJECT FINAL IS/MND ERRATA

Introduction

The California Public Utilities Commission published the Final Initial Study/Mitigated Negative Declaration (IS/MND) for the Lassen Substation Project on June 19, 2017. Following publication, minor errors were identified. This errata item clarifies existing text in the Final IS/MND and does not raise new important issues or potentially significant effects to the environment. This change is not a substantial revision as defined in Section 15073.5(b) of the California Environmental Quality Act Guidelines, and therefore, does not require recirculation.

Errata Item

The following errata item provides clarification regarding timing of construction activities within the City of Mount Shasta. Revisions to text in the Final IS/MND are presented in <u>underline</u> (signifying an addition).

Page 4-28: The following sentence has been added to Section 4.7, Construction Schedule:

Work within the City of Mount Shasta would be limited to the hours between 7:00 a.m. and 5:00 p.m. on weekdays.

Page 5.12-8: The regulatory setting has been updated to include the following:

It should be noted that the Mount Shasta General Plan explicitly excludes construction noise for noise thresholds. Specifically, Policy NZ-1.8(c) states (City of Mount Shasta 2007):

NZ-1.8(c): Noise associated with construction activity between the hours of 7 a.m. and 5 p.m. shall be exempt from the standards cited in Table 7-5 [of the Noise Element]. Construction activity outside of this period may exceed the cited standards if an exemption is granted by the City to cover special circumstances.

Page 5.12-13 has been updated as follows to ensure the analysis in Section 5.12.5(d) is consistent with Section 5.12.5(a):

Construction activities in proximity to residential areas would occur between 7:00 a.m. and 5:00 p.m.

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
