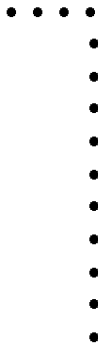

THE A SUB CONTRACTOR "TIERRA ENVIRONMENTAL SERVICES" FOR THE
POWER LINK SOLAR PROJECT, ALSO ON THE IBEROLA TULE WIND
MECCAIN VALLEY PROJECT. AS A NATIVE TRIBAL MEMBER I REQUEST
THAT MY COMMENTS BE KEPT CONFIDENTIAL FROM THE PUBLIC.

I HAVE FIRST HAND KNOWLEDGE OF NEG IMPACTS ON THE NATIVE AMERICAN
CULTURE, LANDS, ANIMALS, BIRDS, SCARCE PLANTS, TREES, CEREMONIAL SITES,
SCARCE BURIAL SITES OF HUMAN CREATED REMAINS, PRELIMINARY SITES
FOR HUMAN CREATION + BURIALS AMONG OTHER IMPORTANT SITES TO NATIVE
AMERICANS OF THESE IMPACTED LANDS. THE THESE PROJECTS THESE
PROJECTS, INCLUDING THE SUNRISE SOLAR PROJECT, HAVE 100% NEG IMPACTS
TO ALL NATIVE ENCOUNTERED SITES IN THAT THEY ARE DESTROYING MANY
OF THESE SITES IRREVERSABLE! WE ARE BEING BLOCKED OFF FROM THESE SITES BY THE

I LIVE WITHIN A 1/2 MILE, BY ROAD, TO THE CURRENT CAMPORES WIND FARM AND WITHIN 1/4 MILE BY DIRECT SIGHT. THE QUESTIONS AS TO "WHAT HAPPENED" "WHAT CAUSED THE BLUE FLASH OF LIGHT" "HOW COULDNT THE TURBINES BE SHUT DOWN RIGHT AWAY" "HOW FAR WERE SOME OF THE BROKEN BLADES PIECES THROWN" "HOW CLOSE WAS THE NEAREST BROKEN FLUNG BLADE THROWN TO THE FREEWAY I-8?" THESE QUESTIONS HAVE NEVER BEEN ANSWERED TO MY KNOWLEDGE. THERE COME TAN FLASHING LIGHTS NOT ONLY DISTURBE HUMANS BUT MUST ALSO DISTURB THE ANIMALS!
