The Energy Division of the California Public Utilities Commission (CPUC) has completed its review of the Sacramento Natural Gas Storage Project (SNGS) Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity (CPCN) Application (Application No. 07-04-013, dated April 9, 2007) and the Proponent's Environmental Assessment (PEA).

Section 15100 of the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) requires the agency responsible for the certification of a proposed project to assess the completeness of the project proponent's application. The Energy Division uses the Commission's Information and Criteria List as the basic guide for determining the adequacy of project applications.

SNGS LLC responded to the CPUC's July 12, 2007, and February 15, 2008, completeness reviews on August 10, 2007, October 16, 2007, March 13, 2008, and March 31, 2008. After completing our review of SNGS LLC's supplemental information, the CPUC Energy Division concludes that the Application and PEA contain sufficient information to satisfy the requirements of the Commission's Information and Criteria List and can now be deemed complete. This determination has been made with the understanding that SNGS LLC will provide a Risk of Upset Study in May 2008 in accordance with Data Request #2.
