The California Public Utilities Commission's (CPUC) Energy Division CEQA Unit has completed its review of San Diego Gas and Electric Company's (SDG&E) application (A. 17-06-029) and related Proponent's Environmental Assessment (PEA) for a Permit to Construct.

Section 15100 of the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) requires the agency responsible for the certification of a proposed project to assess the completeness of the project proponent's application. The Energy Division uses CPUC's Information and Criteria List and PEA Checklist as the guide for determining the adequacy of project applications.

The Energy Division finds that the application including SDG&E's responses to the deficiency report dated August 28, 2017 contain sufficient information to satisfy the requirements of the Commission's Information and Criteria List and deems this application complete.
