Dear Mr. Horne:

On December 21, 2007, the Energy Division of the California Public Utilities Commission (CPUC) issued a determination that Southern California Edison Company's consolidated application/PEA for the Fogarty Substation/Valley-Ivyglen 115 kV Subtransmission Line Project contained sufficient information to satisfy the completeness requirements of the CPUC's Information and Criteria List. The determination was made with the understanding that the Energy Division could request additional data, as necessary, to further evaluate the environmental effects of the proposed project in accordance with requirements of the California Environmental Quality Act.

On February 6, 2008, the CPUC held a scoping meeting in the City of Lake Elsinore to solicit public comments and concerns regarding the proposed Fogarty/Valley-Ivyglen project. During the meeting, the CPUC received numerous concerns regarding SCE's preferred alternative, specifically with respect to constructing the subtransmission line through a portion of the City of Lake Elsinore. Numerous suggestions were made to avoid or mitigate the impacts associated with the construction of the line through the community.

The Energy Division hereby requests SCE to submit additional data regarding any possible solutions or alternatives developed by SCE to mitigate the concerns expressed by the public during the scoping meetings held in Lake Elsinore. The Energy Division will evaluate all data submitted in response to this request and make a determination as to the appropriateness of incorporating the information into the draft document.
