Dear Ms. Kaminsky:

San Diego Gas & Electric Company (SDG&E) is requesting authorization from the California Public Utilities Commission (CPUC) to commence construction of select activities that are in addition to the activities previously authorized under Notice to Proceed No. 2 (NTP-2) for the South Orange County Reliability Enhancement (SOCRE) Project. The CPUC approved NTP-2 on December 18, 2017 for site preparation and construction staging activities at the future San Juan Capistrano Substation. Addendum No.1 to NTP-2 involves a modified alignment of the relocated interior fence separating the upper and lower yards, removal of three de-energized 138 kilovolt (kV) rack structures (located in the upper yard), and associated hazardous materials abatement activities. These activities comprise limited construction activities supporting the full buildout of the proposed San Juan Capistrano Substation, further described in the Final Environmental Impact Report (FEIR) for SOCRE (Decision D.16-12-064).

NTP-2 is hereby granted by the CPUC for the proposed additional construction activities described in SDG&E's Addendum No. 1 to the South Orange County Reliability Enhancement Project Notice to Proceed Request No. 2 (dated March 12, 2018) and the understanding that SDG&E and its contractor(s) will meet all conditions identified in the CPUC's approval letter for NTP-2 (dated December 18, 2017).
