The California Public Utilities Commission (CPUC) Energy Division, California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) Unit has conducted a review of SCE's Proponent's Environmental Assessment (PEA) for the Cal City Substation 115 kV Upgrade Project (Project) relative to the CPUC's Guidelines for Energy Project Applications Requiring CEQA Compliance: Pre-filing and Proponent's Environmental Assessments (November 12, 2019). After conducting an initial review of the PEA, the Energy Division finds that the PEA contains sufficient information to satisfy the requirements of the Commission's Information and Criteria List and deems the Permit to Construct (PTC) application complete.

The Energy Division is requesting additional information (see Data Request #1 attached to this letter) to supplement and inform the environmental review. Please note that as the environmental review progresses, the CPUC may submit clarifying questions or request additional data, as necessary, to prepare a complete and adequate analysis of the potential environmental effects of the proposed Project in accordance with the requirements of CEQA.
