Final EIR Errata

Introduction

The California Public Utilities Commission (CPUC) published the Final Environmental Impact Report (EIR) for the Moorpark-Newbury 66 kV Subtransmission Line Project on October 30, 2015. Following publication, a minor error was identified. It was determined that it would be resolved and the resulting minor revisions published as errata to the Final EIR. These errata merely clarify existing text in the EIR and do not raise important new issues about significant effects on the environment. Such changes are insignificant as the term is used in Section 15088.5(b) of the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) Guidelines.

Errata

An error has been discovered in the Draft EIR relative to the treatment of past project activities in the cumulative impacts discussions. The error, which indicates that past activities would not have continuing effects that could combine with those of the Proposed Project, occurs at two locations in the Draft EIR: first, in the fifth paragraph on p. 2-2, and second in the third sentence of the third paragraph on p. 7-1. The Final EIR acknowledged and corrected the first occurrence of the error on Draft EIR p. 2-2, but inadvertently did not correct the second occurrence of the error on Draft EIR p. 7-1.

It was the intent of CPUC staff to correct the error in the Final EIR for all occurrences in the Draft EIR. Therefore, the following corrections have been made to the Final EIR:

Chapter 7. Cumulative Effects

No text changes have been made to Chapter 7, Cumulative Effects

In addition, as described in Chapter 2, *Background*, to the extent that past construction activities have continuing effects that could combine with the Proposed Project, these components are analyzed as "past projects" that have been completed for the project are not included in this cumulative scenario and are considered to be part of the baseline for the Proposed Project.
