That transmission line, would connect the existing Pacific Gas and Electric Company (PG&E) Newark 230 kV Substation to the existing Silicon Valley Power (SVP) Northern Receiving Station (NRS) 230 kV Substation. The Project would also include modifications to the existing PG&E Newark 230 kV Substation and the existing SVP NRS 230 kV Substation, which would be necessary to interconnect LSPGC's new transmission line. These substation modifications would be constructed by PG&E and SVP, respectively, and each entity would continue to operate its own substation and equipment.
