Horizon Water and Environment Mail - Addendum #3 and MPR Request #3 / Suncrest Construction Fire Prevention Plan (CFPP)

The Suncrest Construction Fire Protection Plan (CFPP) calls for vehicles and equipment to be parked with a 30 foot clearance from vegetation. This distance between parked equipment and vegetation has been determined to be unnecessary and impracticable for crews and equipment on the ground. Instead, the contractor is proposing a 10 foot buffer between parked equipment and vegetation. Per James Pine, Assistant Fire Marshall for San Diego County Fire, on 3/18/19, he accepts a revision to the CFPP that vehicles are to be parked in areas devoid of any vegetation and with a minimum distance of 10 feet from any vegetation.
